




	<p>JAMES SUCKLING</p>	<p>Juin 2022 :  / </p> <p>A medium-bodied Pomerol with ripe berries and medium, ripe tannins, as well as coffee-bean and walnut undertones to the dark fruit. Attractive.</p>
	<p>WINE ADVOCATE ROBERT PARKER WILLIAM KELLEY</p>	<p>Juin 2022 :  / </p> <p>This 2.5-hectare Pomerol estate below Château Rouget, vinified by Paul Junet, has turned in a solid performance with the 2021 Le Moulin. Medium to full-bodied, velvety and polished, it's a generous, fleshy wine evocative of sweet berries, cherries and plums.</p>

Ripe plums, hints of figs, wood spices and hints of nougat and a fine herbal savouriness. Medium-bodied palate of red cherries with ripe, silky tannins, chocolate touches and a vibrant finish. Needs time to reach its full potential</p>
